



## House Policy

### Alcohol Policy

Sullivan's Taproom recognises the importance of holding a liquor licence and in doing so accepts the responsibilities in strictly adhering to the liquor licensing laws. To ensure that alcohol is served responsibly the following rules will apply when alcohol is served:

- Persons under the age of 18 will not be served or provided with alcohol. Photographic ID will be required as proof of age, e.g.: Garda Age Card, Passport, Driver's License, EU National ID Card. Original Copies ONLY
- Alcohol will not be served to persons who are intoxicated
- Persons who are intoxicated will not be permitted on to the premises
- Persons who are intoxicated will not be permitted to remain on the premises
- Persons under the age of 18 will not be permitted after 9pm (Winter) and 10pm (Summer)
- Persons under the age of 18 will not be permitted after 5pm without being accompanied by a Guardian.
- No person may buy alcohol for those persons under 18 years of age
- Persons under the age of 15 will only be permitted in Sullivan's Taproom if accompanied by a Guardian.
- Neat dress essential - no fancy dress, sashes or tracksuits
- Management Reserve the right to refuse service where customer's presence interferes with the safety and wellbeing of other patrons and the establishment itself

### Responsible Serving of Alcohol

- Disorderly conduct will not be tolerated
- Only alcohol purchased in Sullivan's Taproom may be consumed on the premises.
- Non & Low alcoholic drinks will be served at all times alcohol is served
- Tap water will be provided free of charge from the bar

### Tipping Policy

- 100% of tips are given to staff and managed by themselves.
